LOCAL 154 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Rules and Regulations

- 1. The Local 154 Scholarship Program will distribute scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each to three children currently registered for an undergraduate or graduate degree or at a technical or business school. The children must be the dependents of Local 154 members in good standing. The purpose of this scholarship is to help the winners pay for the tuition, registration, or materials at an undergraduate or graduate college or at technical or business school. Grant moneys will be disbursed once satisfactory proof of registration and attendance is presented to Local 154 Executive Board. Such documentation, in the form of a letter from the college or school, shall be received no later than December 15 of the year in which the scholarship is issued.
- 2. Participation will be open to daughters and sons of Local 154 members. Also, other dependent children who are members of the household of Local 154 members will be allowed to participate when the dependency and residency could be demonstrated at the satisfaction of Local 154 Executive Board. Dependents of the President of Local 154 are not eligible to participate.
- 3. Each year the winners of the scholarships will be selected and announced during the September general membership meeting. The winners will be chosen through a random selection process where each participant will have an equal chance to win.
- 4. To participate in the selection process, a Local 154 member shall submit one application form for each of his or her qualifying dependants to Local 154 at 125 Barclay, New York, NY 10007. Separate applications shall be submitted every year in which the member wants to participate.
- 5. Winners of the Local 154 Scholarship shall not be eligible to participate in future drawings of the same.
- 6. All taxation and reporting of the money received will be responsibility of the winners and their parents or guardians.
- 7. All applications, proof of registration and any other official communication with the Local 154 Scholarship Program shall be addressed to AFSCME Local 154 at 125 Barclay Street, New York, NY 10007. All applications shall be received no later than September 1st of the corresponding scholarship year.
